On Friday, 10 December we had our Christmas party at the Piatto restaurant at the Holiday Inn. Everyone had a wonderful time and really enjoyed the food and drinks.

A new range of airless air-operated paint spraying pumps has been developed and the first of the range will be marketed in South Africa as the Hawk 12000P. This unit converts air pressure into airless paint pumping at a ratio of 40:1. In other words, the paint will be sprayed at 40 bar. The sprayed paint can then be applied as pure airless, or with a special gun as a blend of paint and air. This means that the unit has the speed advantage of airless with good finish quality. The paint only comes into contact with stainless steel. The air motor is such that the unit will not pulse, will not stall and will not ice up as other brands do. The displacement is 11 l/min and the maximum nozzle is 0.041 (41 thou) Priced correctly, this should be a winner.
